I. PURPOSE

To informally meet with the leaders of the Republican Party while they are in Washington.

II. BACKGROUND, PARTICIPANTS, PRESS PLAN

A. Background: The National Committee, as well as its Executive Committee, Arrangements and Rules Committees will be meeting from Wednesday to Saturday this week at the Sheraton National Motor Hotel in Arlington. (Schedule of Events attached at Tab A). The Committee last met on September 8-9, 1975, in Washington at which time you hosted a reception for the group at the White House.

NOTE: The President Ford Committee is absorbing the cost of this reception.

B. Participants: Members of the Republican National Committee and their spouses; members of the White House staff; members of the President Ford Committee. A listing of all the participants is attached at Tab B.

C. Press Plan: Reception to be announced. Press pool coverage only.

III. TALKING POINTS

1. The Republican Party has a great responsibility in 1976 as our democratic system moves towards the election of new representatives of the people.
2. This responsibility affects our party at all levels. We must be represented by the best candidates. We cannot afford any less.
3. Cutting back on big government and fiscal responsibility, basic Republican tenets, are being hailed throughout the country as the most elementary of truths. There is a realism that what we stand for is right.
4. We have the opportunity to establish a Republican era in this country. An era created by the people rebelling against the excesses of Democrat-controlled Congresses.
5. We must broaden the base of our party and work together to achieve this goal.
