I would suggest that the President make two telephone calls during his visit to Charlotte this Saturday. These telephone calls could be made during the Personnel/Staff time after 12 noon.

MRS. H. FRANK (MORROW) GRAHAM. Mrs. Graham is the mother of Reverend Dr. Billy Graham. She is a resident of Charlotte and her home is three blocks from the President Ford Committee Headquarters. The President will drive past her home on his way to and from the President Ford Committee Reception. Mrs. Graham recently celebrated her 84th birthday (February 23.) Mrs. Graham receives many visitors coming to Charlotte and President Nixon visited her home in 1969. According to local sources and Dr. Graham, Mrs. Graham is a supporter of the President. Her husband died in 1962.

SUSAN VIRKLER (MRS. HOWARD VIRKLER, JR.). Susan Virkler is co-chairman of the Mecklenburg County President Ford Committee in Charlotte. She developed a case of pneumonia after becoming ill with the flu and continuing to work in the telephone center. She went into the hospital earlier this week and will be reached either at home or Presbyterian Hospital.
