PURPOSE To ask Rosenzweig to run as a Delegate  
to the National Convention

BACKGROUND The Arizona Republican State Convention is  
Saturday, April 24. Rosenzweig, GOP Chairman  
for the last ten years, was asked by Rog Morton  
when he was in Arizona on April 5 to run for  
Delegate. Rosenzweig was on the fence as to  
whether or not to run and it is felt that a phone  
call from the President would be the extra nudge  
needed to persuade him to enter the race.

The PFC Co-Chairmen in Arizona,  
Burton Kruglick (Phoenix) and Barbara Panoff  
(Tucson), expect that the President will get no  
more than 8 or 9 of the 29 delegates. Rosenzweig  
would be one more for the President who could be  
a winner. Congressman John Conlan (4th District,  
2nd term) and his supporters are strongly pro-  
Reagan and will dominate the Convention.

TOPICS OF DISCUSSION What is happening in Arizona?

I know the State Convention is this Saturday and  
that John Conlan is strong.

I'd appreciate your help and the biggest help you  
can offer now is to run as a Delegate.
