TO: Senator Henry Bellmon

WHEN: Before noon on Thursday, May 13, 1976

PURPOSE: To ask him to run as a Delegate at the Oklahoma State Convention, Saturday, May 15th

RECOMMENDED BY: H. James Field, Jr. *H.J.F.*

BACKGROUND:

1. Senator Bellmon has publicly endorsed the President.
2. He is perhaps the one person who can get elected on Saturday and can assure us a voice from that state at the Convention.
3. It might also open the way for Paula Unruh, the Oklahoma GOP Chairman, to run in support of the President Saturday as well.
