BACKGROUND: FULKERSON IS PRESENTLY LEANING FORD

OPPOSE FULKERSON'S RE-ELECTION BID AT  
THE MISSOURI STATE CONVENTION ON JUNE 12.

HE HAS NO PHILOSOPHICAL TIES TO REAGAN  
AND SHOULD BE SUPPORTING THE PRESIDENT.

HE IS A CATTLEMAN AND CATTLE AUCTIONEER.

1. REQUEST SUPPORT AT DISTRICT CONVENTION AND STATE CONVENTION.

3. MENTION THAT HE HAS SUPPORT OF GOVERNOR BOND, NATIONAL COMMITTEE-WOMAN GINN AND FULKERSON SHOULD JOIN THE TEAM.

BACKGROUND: Fulkerson is presently leaning Ford  
but is hesitating to commit because  
of a threat by the Reagan people to  
oppose Fulkerson's re-election bid at  
the Missouri State Convention on June 12.

He has no philosophical ties to Reagan  
and should be supporting the President.

He is a cattleman and cattle auctioneer.

TALKING POINTS:

1. Request support at District  
Convention and State Convention.
2. Ask him to make as many calls as  
possible to produce votes at the  
convention.
3. Mention that he has support of  
Governor Bond, National Committee-  
woman Ginn and Fulkerson should  
join the team.
