PURPOSE : Discuss California primary results and thank all those who have supported his campaign efforts in California.

BACKGROUND : There will be a party for all PFC staff and volunteers at the Downtown Hilton in L.A. Estimated crowd...500 people.

California Attorney General Evelle Younger will probably answer the phone. Other people expected to attend are: San Diego Mayor Pete Wilson (maybe); GOP Chairman Paul Haerle (Harley); State Senator Dennis Carpenter; Nita Ashcraft (maybe) Northern California Coordinator; Chuck Bakaly (Back-lee); Leon Parma (maybe); and Jack Ford (maybe).

POINTS OF DISCUSSION :

- 1) Thank everyone, especially volunteers, for supporting your campaign in California.
- 2) Understand the uphill battle we had in California and appreciate the dedication that went into this campaign.
- 3) Discuss results of Ohio and New Jersey and emphasize positive aspects of both.
- 4) Hope their enthusiasm will continue into the general election -- after victory in Kansas City.

NOTE: There will be media present as well as PFC staff and volunteers.
