June 8, 1976

TO : CONGRESSMAN BILL ARMSTRONG (Colorado)

DATE : ASAP (before the end of this week)

RECOMMENDED BY : STU SPENCER *Srs*

PURPOSE : To urge that he run for national convention delegate at the upcoming GOP Congressional District Convention.

BACKGROUND : In Colorado, 15 of the state's 31 national convention delegates are elected from the congressional districts (3 per district) at conventions held between now and the State Convention on July 10. The 1st Congressional District elected three Reagan delegates last weekend; the remaining districts elect delegates prior to the July 10 State Convention, where 16 at large delegates will be elected.

In Cong. Armstrong's Fifth District it would be to our benefit if Armstrong would run for delegate even if uncommitted to a Presidential candidate.

Armstrong is publicly neutral; Rog Morton previously requested public support for you but was declined. Armstrong privately alleges that he favors you. Armstrong's district is very conservative.

POINTS OF DISCUSSION

- 1) Inquire about Armstrong's congressional race this year -- his prospects this Fall, with particular reference to effects of Presidential campaign on his contest.
- 2) Ask for his analysis of Colorado's National Convention delegation as it will finally be selected.
- 3) Urge Armstrong to run as uncommitted delegate in his own district. To do so would help you since the district would otherwise produce three Reagan delegates. We should have a better opportunity to elect outright Ford delegates at the State Convention.
