

SUBJECT: Summary of Visits by Heads of Government and Chiefs of State

There follows an updated summary of visits by Heads of Government and Chiefs of State:

July 27-28 Official Visit to Washington by Prime Minister Fraser of Australia
(arrival ceremony, office meeting, and dinner. Possible second office meeting.)

August 3-4 State Visit by President Kekkonen of Finland
(arrival ceremony, office meeting, and dinner)

September 14 State Visit by President Geisel of Brazil
(We still have not received final acceptance from the Brazilians. It is possible that Geisel may be unable to make the visit at this time.)

September 22-23 State Visit by President Tolbert of Liberia
(arrival ceremony, office meeting and dinner)

October 5 State Visit by President Perez of Venezuela
(There are some indications that the Venezuelans may ask to reschedule the visit to November or December, but we do not have a final response.)

Fall (hopefully during last half of September) President-elect of Mexico Lopez Portillo
(private, informal meeting)

- Fall In connection with visits by Heads of State and Government to the United Nations General Assembly there will undoubtedly be additional requests for office or courtesy calls. I will submit recommendations to you on such meetings when the actual situation becomes clear.
- Undetermined Official Visit to Washington by Prime Minister Bandaranaike of Sri Lanka
(An invitation has been extended for a mutually convenient time. Mrs. Bandaranaike had hoped to visit Washington in connection with her visit to the United Nations in late September. However, she has now decided that she must return to her country following her address.)
- Undetermined Proposed State Visit by President Kenyatta of Kenya
(You have for decision my recommendation that he be invited to make a State Visit at a mutually convenient time.)
