## COMMENTS ON KEY STATES YET TO SELECT COMMITTEES

Georgia - Mattingly should be asked immediately if two open minded people from Georgia can be selected to serve on Credentials. We can expect the closest Ford-Reagan vote in that committee. I project 3 Ford, 5-Reagan from Georgia.

Indiana - We are working with the Party leadership to try to get Ford people elected as Reagan delegates at the convention this weekend. This may not be successful but we should have some bargaining position to get committee appointments.

Florida - Bill Taylor was elected Chairman of the delegation with the power to appoint committee members. Those appointments have not been made. Taylor has told us that Mike Thomson will not be on a committee. Jack Insco worked the meeting for us this weekend and will continue to do so. I project a 6-2 split in our favor.

Maryland - Bill Kendel is working with the Maryland delegation. This is a potential problem because of internal problems in our Maryland party. I project a 6-2 split in our favor.

North Dakota - It is important that we get two credentials committee people here. We probably will not be able to get all of the appointments because, among the reasons, there may not be enough Ford uncommitted delegates. I project a 5-3 split in our favor.

Tennessee - This is a possible pick up because we have the edge in delegates actually for us; i. e. , 5 of Reagan's 'votes' are for Ford. I project a 5-3 split in our favor.

Iowa, Colorado & W. Virginia - I can not project these at this time.
