

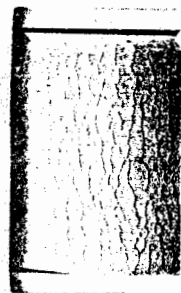
Dear George:
