Attached is the information you requested relating to the selection of the XM-l turbine engine tank.

BRENT SCOWCROFT

At Tab A is a letter describing the specific advantages of the turbine engine as compared to the diesel engine. At Tab B is a more complete discussion, complete with backup charts, describing the process and rationale for the selection of the Chrysler tank and turbine engine.

It seems clear that the selection was made by the Army itself and subsequently ratified by the Defense Department. There is no apparent dissent from any quarter to either the tank itself or the selection of the turbine rather than the diesel engine.
