QUOTE

WE HAVE DEALT WITH SEVERAL IMPORTANT ALLIANCE ISSUES
DURING THE LAST DAY AND A HALF. BUT THERE HAS BEEN ONE
THOUGHT WHICH HAS APPEARED AGAIN AND AGAIN - THAT THIS
IS THE LAST TIME THAT THE COUNCIL HAS DR. HENRY KISSINGER
HERE AS HIS COUNTRY'S REPRESENTATIVE. THIS WILL NOT BE
AN EASY IDEA TO GET USED TO.

MR. SECRETARY, FOR MANY YEARS YOU HAVE BEEN, AFTER
THE PRESIDENT HIMSELF, THE MAIN ARCHITECT OF AMERICAN
DIPLOMACY. YOU HAVE HAD AN ENORMOUS INFLUENCE ON THE
SHAPE OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OF OUR TIME YOU HAVE
BEEN ESSENTIALLY A MAN OF ACTION - A MAN WHO HAS MADE
THINGS HAPPEN - A MAN WHO HAS BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN BRING-
ING PEACE AND SECURITY TO MANY PARTS OF A VERY TROUBLED
WORLD.

BUT IT IS NOT SO MUCH YOUR OVERALL CAREER THAT I WOULD LIKE TO ADDRESS, MR. SECRETARY; RATHER IT IS YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH US HERE IN THE ATLANTIC COMMUNITY. THAT IT HAS BEEN SO SUCCESSFUL IS PERHAPS DUE IN PART TO THE FACT THAT YOU ARE A MAN OF BOTH EUROPE AND AMERICA WITH A VERY SPECIAL AND DEEP UNDERSTANDING OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO. EVEN IN DIFFICULT MOMENTS, WE COULD BE SURE THAT YOU UNDERSTOOD OUR WISHES AND ASPIRATIONS, AS WELL AS THE COMPLEX POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC REALITIES OF OUR VARIOUS COUNTRIES.

YESTERDAY YOU STRESSED THAT THE NORTH ATLANTIC ALLIANCE IS THE BEDROCK OF AMERICAN FOREIGN POLICY. MR. SECRETARY, YOU HAVE GIVEN REPEATED PROOF OF THAT BY THE INITIATIVE AND CREATIVITY WITH WHICH YOU HAVE DEFENDED THE INTERESTS OF OUR ALLIANCE. AS A LEADING MEMBER OF THE PAST TWO AMERICAN ADMINISTRATIONS, YOU HAVE RESOLUTELY AND SUCCESSFULLY OPOSED ANY UNILATERAL WITHDRAWAL OF AMERICAN FORCES FROM EUROPE OR ANY WEAKENING OF YOUR COUNTRY'S COMMITMENT TO OUR DEFENSE. BUT THE ALLIANCE IS MUCH MORE THAN ITS MILITARY STRENGTH. EQUALLY IMPORTANT IS THE COMBINED POLITICAL WILL TO RESPOND TO THE CHALLENGES WHICH FACE US. YOU HAVE WORKED TIRELESSLY TO GIVE LIFE TO THE ESSENTIAL CONCEPT OF FULL CONSULTATION AMONG ALLIES ON THE BASIS OF EQUALITY. AND YOU HAVE PRACTISED WHAT YOU HAVE

MENT TO THE ALLIANCE IS GREATER NOW AMONG OUR GOVERN-
MENTS AND AMONG OUR PEOPLES THAN IT HAS BEEN FOR MANY
YEARS. AND THIS IS LARGELY DUE TO THE POSITIVE AND
INSPIRING LEADERSHIP WHICH YOU HAVE GIVEN US.

I SEE NO HARM TO YOUR WELL-KNOWN MODESTY IF FOR A
MOMENT I ADD MY CONTRIBUTION TO THE WAVE OF PRAISE WHICH
IS SHOWERING DOWN ON YOU FROM ALL SIDES.

WE IN THE ALLIANCE HAVE BEEN PRIVILEGED TO WORK WITH
A MAN TO WHOM THE ADJECTIVE "GREAT" CAN BE APPLIED
WITH SINCERITY. MR. SECRETARY, I AM CONVINCED THAT
YOU WILL STAND IN HISTORY AS ONE OF THE MOST EFFECTIVE FOREIGN
MINISTERS OF OUR CENTURY. YOU HAVE UNDERSTOOD
THE UNDERLYING REALITIES OF OUR TIME. YOU HAVE KNOWN
HOW TO INFLUENCE THOSE REALITIES. YOUR GOALS HAVE BEEN
THE GOALS NOT ONLY OF THE FREE WORLD, BUT OF ORDINARY
MEN AND WOMEN EVERYWHERE - PEACE, SECURITY AND
PROSPERITY. AND IN THIS TASK YOU HAVE BROUGHT YOUR
EXTRAORDINARY ENERGY AND OUTSTANDING BRILLIANCE - AS
WELL AS A WELL-KNOWN REFUSAL TO TAKE NO FOR AN ANSWER.
