A. THE COUNTRY WAS MOVING IN THIS DIRECTION BEFORE THE ASSASSINATION OF SEN. ROBERT F. KENNEDY...AND HIS DEATH GAVE THIS MOVEMENT A FORWARD THRUST.

B. THERE IS NOW APPARENT IN THE NATION A GENERAL REVULSION AGAINST VIOLENCE... AND THIS WAS REFLECTED IN HOUSE PASSAGE OF THE TOUGH SENATE ANTI-GRIME BILL. II. THE ANTI*CRIME BILL IS A TOUGH BILL, REGA DLE SOF THE CRITICISM THAT THE GUNS CONTROL PROVISION IS NOT STRONG ENOUGH AND THAT THE PROVISIONS MODIFTING CERTAIN SUPREME COURT RULINGS WILL NOT HOLD UP UNDER COURT TEST.

B. IT FORBIDS THE **MAXABLE** MAIL ORDER SALE OF HANDGUNS -- PISTOLS AND REVOLVERS. IT ALSO BARS OVER THE COUNTER SALES OF SUCH WEAPONS TO MINORS OR TO PERSONS NOT RESIDENTS OF **MAXABLE** THE STATE. SALES OF RIFLES AND SHOTGUNS...THE WEAPONS USED BY GAME HUNTERS...WOULD NOT BE AFFECTED.

C. IT OUTLAWS WIRETAPPING EXCEPT BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS DEALING WITH ORGANIZED CRIME CARACTERIZED OR NATIONAL SECURITY, AND PERMITS IT THEN ONLY WHEN AUTHORIZED BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION FOR A SPECIFIC PURPOSE.

D. IT LEAVES THE ADMISSIBILITY OF CONFESSIONS TO THE TRIAL JUDGE. THUS THE CONGRESS IS LIMITING THE APPLICATION OF SOME OF THE MORE EXTREME SUPREME COURT DECISIONS, SUCH AS IN THE MALLORY AND MIRANDA CASES. (MALLORY'S RAPE CONFESSION WAS THROWN OUT BY THE SUPREME COURT BECAUSER OF "UNNECESSARY DELAY" IN BRINGING HIM INTO COURT. HE WAS FREED AND STAYED FREE FOR 33 MONTHS... UNTIL HE COMMITTED RAPE AGAIN. MIRANDA'S CONFESSION WAS THROWN OUT BY A 5-4 SUPREME COURT DECISION ON THE GROUND HE HAD BEEN QUESTIONED WITHOUT COMPLETE WARNING OF HIS RIGHTS.) THE SENATE BILL...WISELY...DOES NOT PRECLUDE APPEALS. 5/ AAIM NOTES

IV. THE CONGRESS DELAYED FAR TOO LONG IN ENACTING AN SOMNIBUS ANTI*CRIME BILL. THE HOUSE PASSED ITS VERSION OF THE OMNIBUS ANTI*CRIME BILL LAST AUGUST 8. WE HAVE WAITED FAR TOO LONG TO COMPLETE ACTION ON THIS VITAL LEGISLATION, THIS LANDMARK BILL. I DON'T THINK THE AMERICAN PEOPLE WOULD HAVE STOOD FOR FURTHER DELAY OF THE KIND THAT PROBABLY WOULD HAVE RESULTED FROM THE MOVE BY JUDICIARY COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN EMANUEL CELLER TO REJECT THE SENATE BILL AND SEND THE LEGISLATION TO CONFERENCE.

V. THIS LEGISLATION OF AND BY ITSELF WILL NOT HALT THE PLAGUE OF CRIME AND LAWNESSNESS AFFLICTING THIS COUNTRY BUT I BELIEVE IT SIGNALS AND WILL FIGURE IN AN ULTIMATE REVERSAL OF THE SHARP UPTURN IN CRIME SIGNALS INFLICTED UPON THE AMERICAN PEOPLE IN THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS.

VIII. CONGRESS HAS DEALT WITH THE CHIEF CONCERN OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE AND SOCN WILL ACT ON ANOTHER CRUCIAL PROBLEM, THE DETERIORATION OF THE DOLLAR.

A. THE **COMBINATION** HOUSE DEMOCRATIC LEADERSHIP HAS SCHEDULED FORME JUNE 19 A VOTE ON THE COMBINATION SPENDING CUT-TAX INCREASE PACKAGE WHICH IS BITTER ANTI*INFLATION MEDICINE BUT A POTION THAT THE COUNTRY WILL HAVE TO SMALLOW TO SAVE THE DOLLAR.

D. WE ARE IN SERIOUS TROUBLE BECAUSE OF INFLATION...AND IN THE CHIEF CAUSE OF THAT TROUBLE IS GOVERNMENT OVER*SPENDING. WE MUST, THEREFORE, AT LEAST SLOW DOWN THE UPWARD SPIRAL...CLAMP A LID ON THE SPENDING OF MONEY WE DON'T HAVE.

IX. CONGRESS MUST MEET THE DOLLAR CRISIS AND THE CHALLENGE OF INFLATION BECAUSE BOTH THE AMERICANS AND EUROPEANS ARE LOSING CONFIDENCE IN THE DOLLAR. CRISIS OF CONFIDENCE

A. THIS IS THE INEVITABLE RESULT OF HUGE FEDERAL DEFICITS AND A CONSTANT RISE IN THE COST OF LIVING.

B. ACTION IS IMPERATIVE BECAUSE PROGRESS IN AMERICA WILL BE IMPOSSIBLE UNTIL RELATIVE PRICE STABILITY IS RESTORED AND THE ECONOMY MADE SOUND AGAIN.
