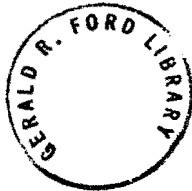

In order to provide further time for Congress to complete action on the basic legislation relating to the Bank, an earlier resolution was recently enacted temporarily extending its life until July 30, 1974. Since Congress has not yet completed that action, the present resolution provides for a further temporary extension until September 30, 1974.

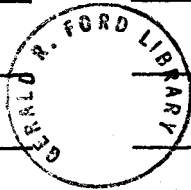

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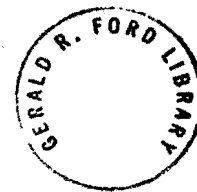
