
Discussion

H.R. 2749 would name a portion of the site of the Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building in Cleveland, Ohio, the "George Washington Square" in honor of the founding father of our nation and the first President of the United States.

H.R. 4206 would designate the new Federal building in Albuquerque, New Mexico, as the "Senator Dennis Chavez Federal Building". Mr. Chavez was a former Congressman and Senator from New Mexico who was elected to the Congress in 1931 and served in the Congress until his death in 1962.

H.R. 14977 would designate the Federal office building in Athens, Georgia, the "Robert G. Stephens, Jr. Federal Building". Representative Stephens has served Georgia's 10th District in the U.S. Congress from 1961 to the present. He is retiring at the end of this Congress.

H.R. 15582 would name the Federal Building in Bluefield, West Virginia, the "Elizabeth Kee Federal Building". The late Congresswoman Maude Elizabeth Kee was elected to the 82nd Congress in 1951 to fill a vacancy caused by the death of her husband and served in the Congress until her retirement in January 1965.

Mr. JONES of Alabama, from the Committee on Public Works and Transportation, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H.R. 2749]

The Committee on Public Works and Transportation, to whom was referred the bill (H.R. 2749) to name a portion of the site of the Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building in Cleveland, Ohio, the "George Washington Square," having considered the same, report favorably thereon without amendment and recommend that the bill do pass.

PURPOSE OF THE BILL

The purpose of the legislation is to name a portion of the site of the Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building in Cleveland, Ohio, the "George Washington Square" in honor of the first President of the United States.

BACKGROUND

The Federal building located at 1240 East Ninth Street, Cleveland, Ohio, was completed in 1967. The steel and glass panel structure contains thirty-four stories. On March 7, 1973, the Federal building in Cleveland, Ohio, was designated the "Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building" in conformance with section 39 of P.L. 92-520, approved October 21, 1972. The Early Settlers Association of the Western Reserve and the Downtown Community Development Program in the City of Cleveland have proposed in commemoration of the Bicentennial to name a portion of the site of the Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building on which has been erected a statue of the first President of the United States, George Washington, as the "George Washington Square".

COMMITTEE VIEWS

The Committee believes it fitting and proper to name a portion of the site of the Anthony J. Celebrezze Federal Building in Cleveland, Ohio, after the founding father of our nation to commemorate the great events of his military and political life.

COST OF THE LEGISLATION

In accordance with rule XIII (7) of the Rules of the House of Representatives, the following information is furnished.

No additional costs to the United States would be incurred in carrying out H.R. 2749, as reported, in the current fiscal year or in any of the 5 fiscal years following.

COMPLIANCE WITH CLAUSE 2(1) OF RULE XI OF THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

(1) With reference to clause 2(1) (3) (A) of rule XI of the Rules of the House of Representatives, no separate hearings were held on the subject matter of this legislation by the Subcommittee on Investigations and Review. However, the Subcommittee on Public Buildings and Grounds held hearings on this subject matter which resulted in the reported bill.

(2) With respect to clause 2(1) (3) (B) of rule XI of the Rules of the House of Representatives the bill, as reported, does not provide new budget authority or increased tax expenditures. Accordingly, a statement pursuant to section 308(a) of the Congressional Budget Act is not required.

(3) With reference to clause 2(1) (3) (C) of rule XI of the Rules of the House of Representatives, the committee has not received an estimate and comparison prepared by the Director of the Congressional Budget Office under section 403 of the Congressional Budget Act.

(4) With reference to clause 2(1) (3) (D) of rule XI of the Rules of the House of Representatives, the committee has not received a report from the Committee on Government Operations pertaining to this subject matter.

(5) With reference to clause 2(1) (4) of rule XI of the Rules of the House of Representatives, H.R. 2749, as reported, will not affect prices and costs since it does not authorize additional funds. Therefore, H.R. 2749, as reported, would not have an inflationary impact on the national economy.

VOTE

The Committee ordered the bill reported by voice vote.

Celebrezze Federal Building in Cleveland, Ohio, lying west of said building, on which has been erected a statue of the First President of the United States, George Washington, shall, from and after the date of enactment of this Act, be known and designated as the "George Washington Square".
