The veto on the Health-Nurses Training Bill was overridden in the House by 384 to 43.

The Elk Hills Bill passed the Senate by the vote of 93-2.

Frank Zarb concluded his testimony before the House Rules Committee today and the Rules Committee is expected to send the bill to the floor for consideration on Wednesday.

The House will consider a Resolution of Disapproval on the President's Decontrol Plan and also the Krueger Amendment to the Dingell Bill. The Krueger Amendment is similar to the President's Decontrol Plan.

The vote on the Resolution of Disapproval on the President's Decontrol Plan is expected to be close.
