US napalm hurt Vietnamese children. Did GF ever speak out on My Lai?

Why isn't the US govt speaking out on behalf of Vietnamese/US war brides and illegitimate children of US men against recriminations?

Don't go half way. Go back all the way to SE Asia with military and humanitarian aid. It's not the American way to go half way.

In the US, we have thousands of Vietnamese war brides. When the communists take over, the families of these women will be tortured and killed. There are one-half million children of US men in Vietnam. No mention has been made of these children whom we owe more to than the 2,000 orphans.

Committee Concerned for Vietnamese Lives, Minneapolis, Minn. Urging open immigration for the Vietnamese to the US as soon as possible. Ask GF to prevail upon Thieu to let the Vietnamese to come to the US. Without regard to government, military, or political position, we're in favor or humanitarian aid. Take steps to insure in the future that the currency and immigration channels are kept open so these families in Vietnam may continue to correspond and maintain their essential relationship.
