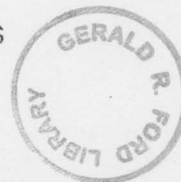

Miscellaneous comments: Week of March 24-28, 1975

Con Military aid to SE Asia. Pro humanitarian aid. Con US intervention except to evacuate US personnel.

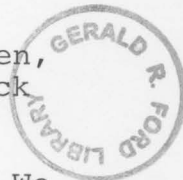
Concerned with the elderly. We can't pay the price to buy the drugs we need. Medication is very costly.


