# PRESIDENTIAL REMARKS FOR ROCKEFELLER PUBLIC SERVICE AWARDS

## WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 4, 1974

I AM VERY PLEASED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS AWARDS LUNCHEON AND TO JOIN IN YOUR SALUTE TO FIVE OUTSTANDING PUBLIC SERVANTS. FOR AS LONG AS THERE HAS BEEN GOVERNMENT AMONG MEN, IT HAS BEEN FASHIONABLE TO ATTACK BUREAUCRACY AND BUREAUCRATS --SOMETIMES FOR GOOD AND SUFFICIENT REASON. AND I HAVE TO CONFESS THAT, IN OVER 25 YEARS ON CAPITOL HILL, I HAVE ON OCCASION JOINED IN THE FRAY WHEN I THOUGHT THE ISSUES AND THE FACTS CALLED

FOR IT. B. Rowww The ISSUES AND THE FACTS CALLED How B. Rowww William & Will BUT THE FACT REMAINS THAT IT IS CAREER PUBLIC SERVANTS WHO KEEP THE VITAL, DAY-TO-DAY BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT MOVING, YEAR AFTER YEAR -- A VAST AND LOYAL ARMY OF GOOD PEOPLE, DOING GOOD WORK FOR THEIR COUNTRY.

TODAY WE ARE PROUD TO HONOR FIVE PUBLIC SERVANTS WHO HAVE DONE MORE THAN JUST SERVE US RIGHT -- THEY HAVE SERVED US WITH DISTINCTION.

COMMENTING ON PUBLIC APATHY, AND ITS EFFECT ON

EACH ONE, IN HIS OWN WAY, HAS MADE AN IMPORTANT, LASTING CONTRIBUTION TO OUR GOVERNMENT, AND OUR FREE WAY OF LIFE. THE FIELDS THESE MEN REPRESENT ARE VARIED -- AERONAUTICS, SOCIAL WELFARE, AND SEVERAL PHASES OF THE ECONOMY -- BUT THE ABILITY AND DEDICATION WHICH EACH HAS BROUGHT TO HIS WORK IS THE SAME.

THEY REPRESENT THE BEST IN A LONG TRADITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE, AND THE UNSUNG MILLIONS OF MEN AND WOMEN WHO WORK IN GOVERNMENT TODAY. ON BEHALF OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, I WANT TO SAY THANK YOU FOR A JOB WELL DONE. YOUR EXAMPLE IS ALREADY AN INSPIRATION TO YOUR FELLOW WORKERS. I HOPE THIS CEREMONY TODAY WILL ALSO MAKE IT AN INSPIRATION TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE YOU SERVE.
