YOUR HOLINESS:

1. IT HAS BEEN A VERY GREAT HONOR FOR US TO MEET WITH YOU TODAY,  
AND MRS. FORD AND I ARE MOST APPRECIATIVE.
2. YOUR CONCERN FOR THE WELLBEING OF MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN EVERYWHERE,  
AND YOUR LEADERSHIP ON HUMANITARIAN ISSUES OF THE GREATEST IMPORTANCE TO MANKIND  
COMMAND THE RESPECT AND THE APPRECIATION OF MEN EVERYWHERE.

3. IN OUR CONVERSATION, WE HAVE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO REVIEW  
SOME OF THESE ISSUES:

4. WE HAVE DISCUSSED THE GREAT CHALLENGE OF ENSURING THAT THERE IS  
ENOUGH FOOD FOR ALL -- THAT NO ONE NEED GO HUNGRY AND UNDERNOURISHED IN ANY  
LAND.

5. WE HAVE DISCUSSED THE VERY DIFFICULT PROBLEM OF REFUGEES  
AND THE NEED TO ASSIST THOSE WHO ARE HOMELESS.

6. I KNOW FROM OUR TALKS TODAY THAT WE ARE BOTH DEDICATED TO REALIZING  
A BETTER LIFE FOR PEOPLE EVERYWHERE.

7. AS PRESIDENT, I WILL CONTINUE TO DEVOTE FOREMOST ATTENTION  
TO THESE ISSUES.

8. I LOOK FORWARD TO PURSUING WITH  
YOU THE OBJECTIVE WE BOTH SHARE, OF A  
WORLD IN WHICH ALL MANKIND HAS THE BLESSINGS  
OF PEACE AND WELL-BEING.
