The N.M.A. feels that your remarks will do much to publicize both their organization and the unique contribution which Meharry has made in the development of minority physicians and community health services.

Your appearance before the convention was strongly recommended by Dr. Jasper Williams, the outgoing President of N. M.A. and a Republican.
