## **FORD URGES VOTE FOR U.S.**

President Ford, accompanied by Mrs. Ford, appeals to Americans to vote in tomorrow's elections. In a statement given in the White House Rose Garden today, Ford warned that a low turnout could bring minority rule to America. "You will not just be voting for Democrats or Republicans," he said, "You will be casting your vote of confidence in the United States of America." He urged voters to "send a message to Washington and the world."
