 - NOTE: Brunch program is attached (Tab A).
- -- After Mr. Boyer sings "Get All Excited," you will return to the platform to address your guests.
- -- After your speech, you will return to your table for the remainder of the program.

The Brunch will conclude with Mr. Boyer singing, "America, the Beautiful. "
