That's right. I figured I had made all my mistakes before the race, and if I just skilled well, I'd win a medal.

You didn't feel any pressure?

CINDY:

Not really, because nobody expected me to do well. Now, though, that might be different. Sheila knows what that's like.

BARBARA:

That's right. Sheila, you are the record holder at 500 meters, so you had to be under pressure.

SHETLA:

That's true, and maybe the pressure spurred me on to the gold medal.

But I had no pressure in the 1,500 meters, which I had never done well in, yet I won a silver medal in that event. So, who knows?

BARBARA:

What does an ice skater do in the summer time?

SHEILA:

Well, I'll be in Sicily. I'm going to enter the world bicycle racing championships.

BARBARA:

Trying something new?

SHEILA:

Not exactly. I competed in 1973, too.

BARBARA:

How did you make out?

SHEILA:

I won the world sprint championship.

BILLIE JEAN:

In sports, you can get an accurate measure of a person by the way he or she handles setbacks.

In the 1968 Olympics, one of our divers was leading the competition, when she hit her arm against the diving board, broke the arm, and finished fourth.

Four years later, she again tried for that gold medal. In the moment of truth, she tried the same dive that had been her downfall, executed it, and won the gold medal.

She teaches physical education to the cadets at the Air Force Academy now, and, as coach of the cadet diving team, is the first woman ever to coach an athletic team at a service academy.

EUNICE SHRIVER:

For those who feel that politics is the domain only of men, our winner is a brilliant contradiction. She is this country's only woman governor.

To those who feel her election was some sort of "fluke," let me point out that in 24 years of public life, she has never lost an election.

When she graduated from high school, her class yearbook predicted she would someday be mayor of her home town. They were too modest. Here now is the Governor of Connecticut, and our Woman of the Year in Political Life, Ella Grasso.


