Subject: Congressional Correspondence

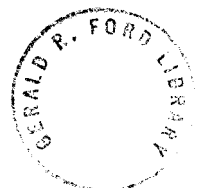
Attached is a list (or rather two lists) of Congressional correspondence which we have received but which, to the best of my knowledge, remains unanswered. (If the correspondence was indeed answered, we have no copy of it in our Congressional correspondence file and, no record of it in the correspondence log book, nor have we been able to locate it elsewhere.)

As you can see, correspondence on the first list has been unanswered for quite some time and repeated attempts by both Larry and me have been unable either to get it answered or located.

Correspondence on the second list is more recent (though some of it is now two months old) and, although unanswered, at least not lost!

At the same time I am sending you this, I am also sending another memorandum to each of the staff members who still have outstanding correspondence (and Carolyn Swanson, who now handles the logging and routing of correspondence has already bugged them repeatedly) - but your clout would undoubtedly help.
