




Most important of all, of course, was John Wayne (Rooster Cogburn), one of Judge Parker's deputies in True Grit, a real Arkie.

Maybe on a slow news day you will produce a story about historic old Fort Smith, where America once jumped off, and where today, because of our President's visit, may have just become a new cradle of democracy.
