FORD MOTOR COMPANY STRIKE

- Q. I appears likely that workers of the Ford Motor Company will go on strike at midnight tonight when their contract expires. What action do you expect to take if this happens?
- A. We are following this very closely, and we hope that the remaining differences between management and the union can be resolved before the midnight deadline. I have discussed this problem with Secretary of Labor Usery. At this point, with negotiations still underway, it would be premature for me to comment in any more detail.
