SUBJECT:

LAKE WINNIPESUAKEE

The Secretary of Transportation this morning will make a statement in which he will ask the Commandant of the Coast Guard to review the pending Lake Winnepesaukee/Lake Winnisquam situation which would make the inter-connectable waterways navigable.

In light of this review, the Coast Guard is revoking its decision of September 2, 1975, pending completion of the review.
