Sir:

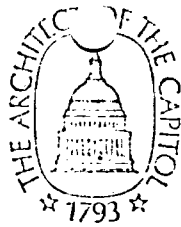
I ask the Congress to consider a proposed supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year 1975 in the amount of \$258,500 for the Supreme Court.
