Sir:

I have the honor to submit for your consideration a proposed supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year 1975, in the amount of \$73,576,000 for the Civil Service Commission as follows:

Independent Agencies

CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

Payment to Civil Service
Retirement and Disability Fund

For an additional amount for "Payment to Civil Service Retirement and Disability Fund", \$73,576,000.

The proposed supplemental appropriation would provide for payments on the unfunded liability created by an increase in retirement benefits required by P.L. 93-260, enacted April 9, 1974, and increases in wage board and general schedule pay rates. These payments to finance increases in unfunded liability are required by P.L. 91-93, approved October 20, 1969. This proposal is an inter-fund transaction and will not increase 1975 budget totals.

I have carefully reviewed the proposal contained in this document and am satisfied that this request is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that it be transmitted to the Congress.
