The President of the United States will have traveled 24,100 miles since taking office when he arrives back at Andrews Air Force Base early tomorrow morning.

His campaign travel mileage, including the current trip, is 16,685 miles. He has made campaign stops in 20 states since taking office. His mileage for the current trip is 5,980 miles.
