The President today announced his intention to nominate James P. Churchill, of Vassar, Michigan, to be a United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Michigan. He will succeed Stephen J. Roth who died on July 11, 1974.

Since 1965, Mr. Churchill has been Circuit Judge of the 40th Judicial Circuit of Michigan. From 1951 to 1965, he practiced law in Vassar, Michigan.

Mr. Churchill was born on April 10, 1924 in Imlay City, Michigan. He received his B. B. A. degree from the University of Michigan and his LL. B. degree from the University of Michigan Law School. He served in the United States Army from 1943 to 1946.

Mr. Churchill is married and has three children.
