The President today announced the appointment of four persons to be Members of the Citizens' Advisory Committee on Environmental Quality for terms expiring May 3, 1977.

They are:

Richard M. Fairbanks, III, of the District of Columbia. He succeeds Rene J. Dubos, whose term expired.

Joseph L. Haller, of Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania. This is a reappointment.

Terese T. Hershey, of Houston, Texas. She succeeds Frank Borman, whose term expired.

Jack B. Olson, of Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin. This is a reappointment.

The Committee was established by Executive Order on May 29, 1969, to advise the President and the Council on Environmental Quality on matters affecting environmental quality.
