Jerry Jones has served as Staff Secretary since April 6, 1974. He has previously served as the head of the White House Personnel Office, a staff assistant in the Personnel Office and as a staff member in the Field Division of the Committee to Re-Elect the President.

Prior to joining the White House, Mr. Jones was President of Symcon, Inc., a manufacturing company operating in McHenry, Illinois (1968-1970); President of Jones Simonds, Inc., an investment company in New York (1967-1970); and a management consultant with McKinsey & Company, New York, New York (1964-1967).

Mr. Jones was born June 13, 1939, in Lamesa, Texas. He graduated cum laude from Harvard College in 1961 and earned an MBA from Harvard Graduate School of Business in 1964. He resides in Washington, D.C.
