Resumption of SALT Talks

In accordance with the understanding reached at Vladivostok on November 24, 1974, between President Ford and General Secretary Brezhnev, the Delegations of the U. S. A. and U. S. S. R. to the Strategic Arms Limitation Talks (SALT) will resume negotiations in Geneva on January 31, 1975, with the objective of working out this year a new agreement limiting strategic offensive arms through December 31, 1985.

The U. S. SALT Delegation will be headed by Ambassador U. Alexis Johnson, accompanied by Members of the Delegation: Dr. Harold Brown, LT. GEN. Edward L. Rowny, USA, Mr. Boris H. Klosson, Mr. Ralph Earle, II, and Dr. Michael M. May. The last round of talks in Geneva ended November 5th.
