NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate Charles W. Robinson, of San Francisco, California, to be United States Alternate Governor of the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development for a term of five years; United States Alternate Governor of the Inter-American Development Bank for a term of five years; and United States Alternate Governor of the Asian Development Bank. In these positions he will succeed William J. Casey who became President of the Export-Import Bank of the United States on March 8, 1974.

Mr. Robinson is presently the Under Secretary of State for Economic Affairs and succeeded William J. Casey in this position.

The President today also announced the designation of Mr. Robinson to serve as a Member of the Board of Directors of the Overseas Private Investment Corporation. He succeeds Willis C. Armstrong who served as an Assistant Secretary of State for Economic and Business Affairs.
