NOTICE TO THE PRESS

President Ford and Prime Minister Wilson continued their talks today on a number of bilateral and international issues of mutual interest. Today's meeting lasted an hour and ten minutes.

Their talks this morning included a review of the situation in the Middle East and the prospects for peace there. The President and the Prime Minister also exchanged views on international developments of current importance to the Atlantic Alliance and other matters of interest to both countries.

The President and the Prime Minister expressed their satisfaction with the cordial state of American-British relations and reiterated the importance of continuing the close consultations which mark that relationship. They agreed to remain in close contact in the coming months.
