

FEDERAL MEDIATION AND CONCILIATION SERVICE


Salaries and Expenses

For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses", to carry out the mediation provisions of the Act of December 22, 1974 (88 Stat. 1712), \$350,000, to remain available until expended.

The proposed supplemental would cover the costs incurred by the mediator which the Act of December 22, 1974, requires the Director of the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service to appoint to help reach a final settlement of the land dispute between the Hopi and Navajo tribes.

I have carefully reviewed the proposal for appropriations and am satisfied that these requests are necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that this proposal be transmitted to the Congress.
