The President today announced his intention to nominate Clarence A. Brimmer, Jr., of Cheyenne, Wyoming, to be United States Attorney for the District of Wyoming for a term of four years. He will succeed Richard V. Thomas who resigned effective December 27, 1974.

Since January, 1975, Mr. Brimmer has served as court appointed United States Attorney for the District of Wyoming.
