THE WHITE HOUSE

The President today announced his intention to nominate John A. Hill, of College Park, Maryland, to be Deputy Administrator of the Federal Energy Administration. This is a new position established by Public Law 93-275, May 7, 1974.

Mr. Hill has been an Associate Director for Natural Resources, Energy Science for the Office of Management and Budget since February 1974. From November 1973 to February 1974, he was Assistant Director for Policy, Planning and Regulation for the Federal Energy Office. He served as Deputy Associate Director for Management, Natural Resources, Energy and Science of the Office of Management and Budget from January 1973 to November 1973. He had previously been with the Office of Management and Budget as Senior Budget Examiner from 1969 to 1971. During the period from March 1971 to January 1973 he was with the Environmental Protection Agency. He was with Educational Associates, Inc. from January 1968 to March 1969.

Mr. Hill was born on January 31, 1942 in Midland, Texas. He received his B. A. degree from Southern Methodist University in 1964.

Mr. Hill is married to the former Marilyn Wood and they have two children.
