TEXT OF LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT
TO THE SECRETARY OF LABOR

Dear Mr. Secretary:

After reviewing the International Trade Commission's report on its investigation TEA-W-260 (under section 301(c)(2) of the Trade Expansion Act of 1962), I have decided (under authority of section 330(d)(1) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended) to concur in the affirmative vote of the Commissioners. You may therefore certify the former workers of the Manchester, New Hampshire, plant of the Shaer Shoe Corporation as eligible to apply for adjustment assistance.
