

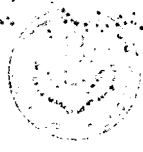
Sir:

Sir:

I have the honor to submit for your consideration a proposed appropriation language change for the fiscal year 1975 which would extend the availability of funds already appropriated. The details are as follows:

OTHER INDEPENDENT AGENCIES

TEMPORARY STUDY COMMISSIONS

National Commission on
Supplies and Shortages

Salaries and Expenses

Funds appropriated under this heading in the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1975, shall remain available until December 31, 1975.

This proposed language change would permit the \$287,500 appropriated in the Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1975, for expenses of the National Commission on Supplies and Shortages to remain available until December 31, 1975. This provision is consistent with recently enacted legislation (Public Law 94-9, approved March 21, 1975) which extended the final reporting date and the authorization for appropriations from June 30, 1975, to December 31, 1975.
