I ask the Congress to consider amendments for the fiscal year 1976 in the amount of \$1,273,000 and for the transition period July 1 through September 30, 1976, in the amount of \$297,000 for the Judiciary.

The details of these proposals are set forth in the enclosures, one of which is a letter from the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts. As required by law (28 USC 605), these proposals are being transmitted without change.
