NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Timothy A. Barrow, of Phoenix, Arizona, as a member of the National Commission for Manpower Policy. He will fill the position vacated by Mayor Thomas Moody, of Columbus, Ohio, who was appointed by the President on September 30, 1974. Mayor Moody has declined to accept the appointment on the basis of the Charter of the City of Columbus, Ohio, prohibiting the Mayor from accepting any public office or employment except the militia or notary public.

Since 1973, Mayor Barrow has been mayor of the City of Phoenix, Arizona. He served in the State Legislature from 1966 until his election as mayor and during this time he also served as Speaker of the House.

Mayor Barrow is married to the former Kathleen O'Donnell and they have five children.
