Conclusion of Wilson Meeting and Motorcade to NATO

President emerged from the embassy residence at about 9:45 a.m. to bid farewell to Prime Minister Wilson, with whom he had had breakfast. Previous pool covered and we took over a few moments later when Mr. Ford set out for the 10-minute drive to NATO Headquarters. Several small groups of spectators, totaling perhaps 100 in all, watched his departure. Similar small knots of spectators stood at a number of spots along his route. Others watched from office and shop windows. All appeared quiet and undemonstrative. President entered NATO Headquarters, and we were barred at front door by Secret Service. Neither saw nor heard anything of him after that.

At 1:30 p.m. when we were to be relieved, Hushen said it had been decided not to send out a new pool. Hushen says Utley is there as electronic pool and also Time and People magazine.
