President's meeting with President Sadat at  
Schloss Fuschl

The Americans and Egyptians dined on consomme and dumplings, fresh pike caught in the lake, venison in mushroom sauce, and strudel with a sweet sauce, and demitasse. No wine was served. They drank either mineral water or orange juice. The President had a 2nd helping of venison.

During the lunch the President and Sadat talked animatedly. Besides the President, other Americans who sat at the head table included Secretary Kissinger; Don Rumsfeld; Joe Sisco; Bob Hartmann; Charles W. Robinson, Under Secretary of State for Economic Affairs; and Herman F. Eilts, Ambassador to Egypt.

Besides Sadat, the other Egyptian officials at the head table included Vice President Hoshny, Moubarak; Foreign Minister Isma'il Fahmi; Minister of Finance Ahmad Abou Isma'il; Hassan Kamel, Chef du Cabinet; and one unidentified official.

Following the lunch, Sadat rose to propose a toast to the President and the President responded with a toast to Sadat. Water instead of wine was used for the toast.

About 15 minutes after the toasts were concluded, the President left the Sadat residence and drove to Schloss Klesheim.
