NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President announced today the appointment of Martin Anderson, of Palo Alto, California, as a member of the Defense Manpower Commission. He will succeed Hastings Keith who resigned effective April 21, 1975

Since 1971, Mr. Anderson has been a Senior Fellow at the Hoover Institute for War Revolution and Peace at Stanford University. He served as Special Assistant to the President from 1969 to 1971.

Mr. Anderson was born on August 5, 1936, in Lowell, Massachusetts, and received his A. B. degree summa cum laude from Dartmouth College in 1957. He received his M. S. degree from Dartmouth in 1958 and his Ph. D. degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1962. He is married to the former Annelise Graebner.
