NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has accepted with deep regret the resignation of Jack Franklin Bennett, of Greenwich, Connecticut, as Under Secretary of the Treasury for Monetary Affairs effective June 30, 1975.

Mr. Bennett has been Under Secretary of the Treasury for Monetary Affairs since June 6, 1974. He was appointed Under Secretary of the Treasury on March 14, 1974, after serving from September 1971 to August 18, 1974 as Deputy Under Secretary of the Treasury.

Mr. Bennett was born on January 17, 1924, in Macon, Georgia. He received his B.A. degree from Yale University in 1944 and his M.A. in 1949 and Ph. D. in 1951 from Harvard University. He is married to the former Elizabeth Goodwin, of Sunderland, Massachusetts, and they have four children. They reside in Washington, D.C.
