NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed S. J. Res. 94--Temporary Extension of the Defense Production Act and National Commission on Productivity and Work Quality--which temporarily extends authorities of the Defense Production Act (DPA) and the funding of the National Commission on Productivity and Work Quality (NCPWQ) from June 30, 1975, to September 30, 1975.

---

The President has signed H. R. 4221--Higher Education "Emergency Technical Provisions Act"--which permits reallocations of funds among institutions within a State under the College Work-Study program; authorizes the carry-over into fiscal year 1976 of unused fiscal year 1975 funds under the Basic Educational Opportunity Grant program; extends the life of the National Advisory Council on Equality of Educational Opportunity. H. R. 4221 will make several changes in education law based upon legislative proposals. It will also extend until September 30, 1976, the life of the National Advisory Council on Equality of Educational Opportunity, which operates in connection with the Emergency School Aid Act.

The President has signed H. R. 6698--Assistance to repatriated Americans; food stamp eligibility for Supplemental Security Income beneficiaries--which makes permanent HEW's authority to provide assistance to U. S. citizens and their dependents who have been repatriated from foreign countries; extends for one year provisions of present law which have the effect of maintaining eligibility of supplemental security income beneficiaries for food stamps through June 30, 1976.
