The President has designated Garth Marston, of Seattle, Washington, as Acting Chairman of the Federal Home Loan Bank Board, to serve in that capacity until such time as a permanent Chairman is designated. The previous Chairman was Thomas R. Bomar who resigned effective June 20, 1975.

Mr. Marston has been a member of the Board since April 10, 1974.
